Step 2: KPIs

1. User Engagement:

Number of active users: The total number of users who actively engage with the app during the specified period.

One constraint or dependency that the Remote Skills Hub solution may have is the availability and quality of internet connectivity. The success and effectiveness of the app heavily rely on users having access to a stable internet connection. Users need a reliable internet connection to access the app, participate in online training courses, search for remote job opportunities.

D. What is one strategy you could use to make this less of a concern?

One strategy to mitigate the concern of internet connectivity limitations is to provide offline functionality within the Remote Skills Hub app. By incorporating offline capabilities, users can access certain features, such as downloading course materials or accessing saved content, even when they are not connected to the internet.

E. What is 1 assumption you've made about your solution or your target users?

One assumption made about the Remote Skills Hub solution is that the target users have a strong motivation and desire to acquire remote skills and find remote job opportunities. It assumes that the users are actively seeking ways to improve their employability in the remote work landscape and are motivated to invest time and effort in accessing the app's resources, completing training courses, and utilizing the job search engine.
